#### Kennedy Center American College Theatre Festival

Started in 1969 by Roger L. Stevens, the Kennedy Center's founding chairman, The Kennedy Center American College Theatre Festival (KCACTF) is a national theatre program involving 18,000 students from colleges and universities nationwide which has served as a catalyst in improving the quality of college theatre in the United States. The KCACTF has grown into a network of more than 600 academic institutions throughout the country, where theatre department and student artists showcase their work and receive outside assessment by KCACTF respondents.
